Incidents of note

Two attempted thefts have been reported in the Tedstone Wafre/Delamere area over the last couple of days whereby offenders have tried to access garages and work units. 0090-S-270717 refers to an incident in Rowden whereby a shed was broken into and tools and garden equipment stolen from within. 0176-S-050717 Trailer, power washer, battery and battery charger were all stolen during a theft from an open fronted barn in Thornbury.

Please be vigilant whilst out and about, lock all garden equipment away and report anything suspicious on 101. If you have a property marker, please make sure you mark your items, if you would like a FREE marker pen, please give me a shout.

0154-S-220717 A vehicle parked in Bromyard has had the tools and equipment stolen from within. The locks to the van had NOT been damaged, thieves had used a specialised tool to open the standard van locks. If you do leave tools in your vehicle, it is worth investing in an armoured style lock like this:



0696-S-140717 An unusual one, a spare wheel has been stolen from underneath a Land Rover. It is not known exactly where the offence occurred, but please keep an eye on yours if you have one!

0390-S-110717 Further to my last briefing an honesty box was stolen from a driveway in Boat Lane, Whitbourne. Please empty them at regular intervals.

0247-S-040717 Theft of diesel/fuel from a property in Ocle Pychard. Due to the location, nothing was seen or heard.
